



Should I age my beer ?

Have I had it before ?

Do I have 2 or more bottles ?

Drink at least one fresh, follow the flowchart for the rest.

Is it an IPA ?

Almost every IPA is meant to be drunk fresh. There are some exceptions to this rule. DFH 120 and other heavier "Imperial", "Barleywine" or some barrel aged versions may be aged.

Is your IPA one of those?

Is it a standard shelf beer, available year round ?

If it is a standard 6 pack of beer, there is not much benefit to aging it in most cases

You should probably drink it fresh

Is there coffee in it ?

Coffee flavors will fade over time. Decide if you're ok with this

Are you ok with this ?

Does it have less than 7% ABV

Is a Belgian Style and bottle Conditioned ?

Do you have a dark closet or fridge

Is is temp controlled or with little temp variations

Feel free to age it
